- 2. Registered vendors can purchase up to 2 tickets to the show for just \$6 with the purchase of each table.
- 3. No established businesses allowed.

What comes with my space?

- Each space comes with a 6' table and 1 chair.
- No electrical power is furnished.
- If you purchase a ticket to the show, it will be in the form of a badge, good for one day only. You may use the Main Entrance, but we encourage you to use the Exhibitor Entrance located on the south side of the Expo Hall.
- Badges can be picked up at the Exhibitor Entrance on the day you've registered for your space.

Show Hours

Friday, January 26 - noon to 7:00 p.m.

Saturday, January 27 - 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Sunday, January 28 - 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

General Rules

- > The sale of fireworks, adult items, and drug paraphernalia is prohibited.
- Food items cannot be sold.
- No guns can be displayed or sold.
- All items must be retained within the boundaries of assigned area.
- An area in the parking lot will be set aside for larger items (boats, etc.) which can be sold for 5% commission to Shuyler Productions.
- All sales and disputes are strictly between you and the buyer.
- Items cannot be left unattended. Neither Shuyler Productions, nor the HAPO Center management, nor the City of Pasco, nor Franklin County will be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged merchandise or equipment.
- You are not required to stay in the designated Marketplace area after your items are sold.
- No loud music, stereos or games are permitted.
- Items are for sale during show hours only.
- Vendors must leave the facility when show is over but are allowed in the facility one hour prior to show opening, using Exhibitor Entrance only. You must be pre-registered to enter prior to show opening.
- You are responsible for cleaning up your area before leaving. Any items left will be disposed of at the discretion of Sportsmen Show Staff.

HAPO Center Rules and Regulations

- The HAPO Center will enforce a \$50 fee for every floor tile that is broken, deeply gouged or has tape or glue stuck that is not easily removed.
- No food or beverage can be served or sold to the public without prior consent.
- No outside food can be brought into the HAPO Center. Concessions and coffee are sold for your convenience.
- No confetti or glitter can be used within the facility.

Security

Facility janitors will not enter the Marketplace area for security reasons
